



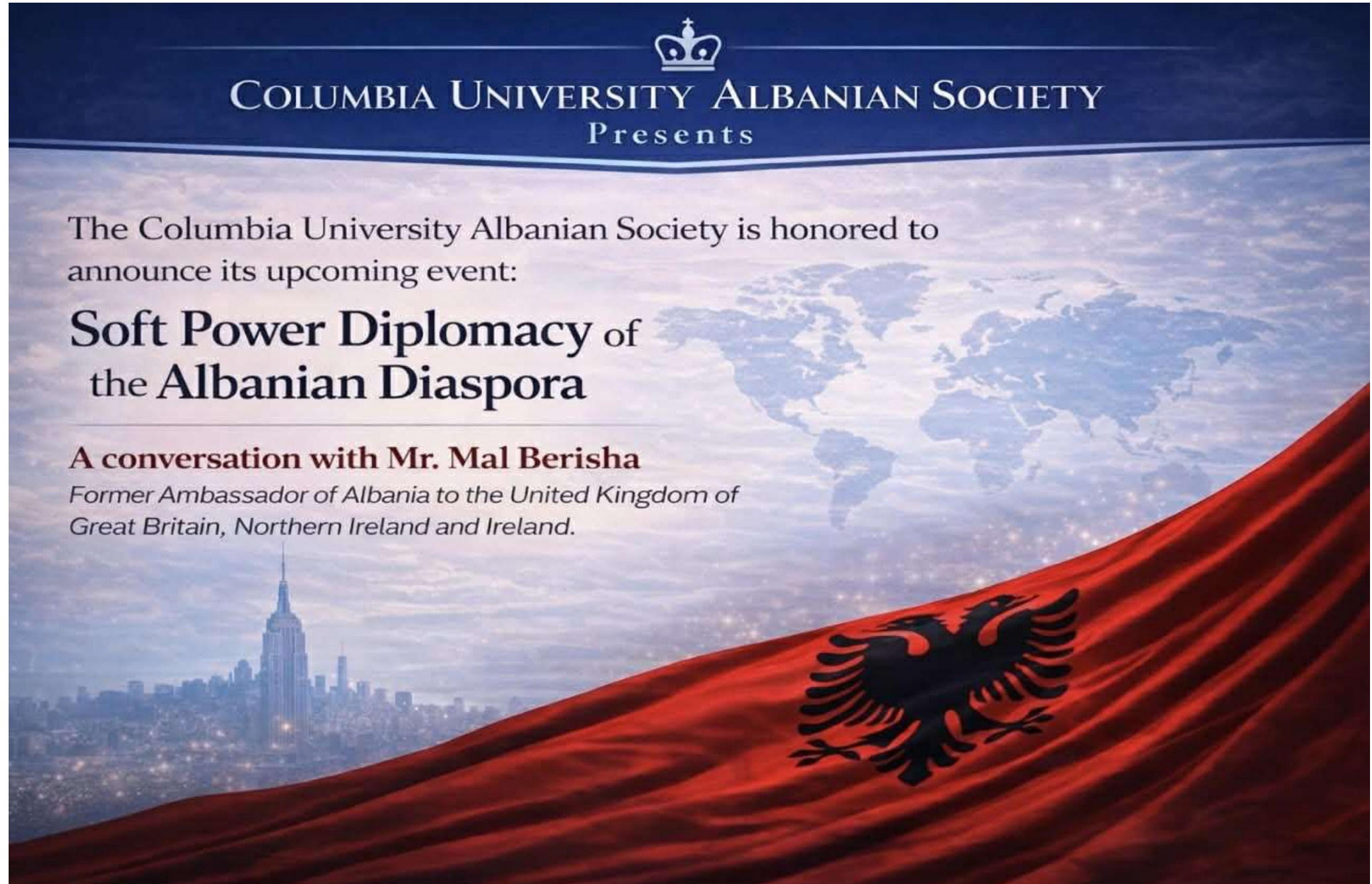

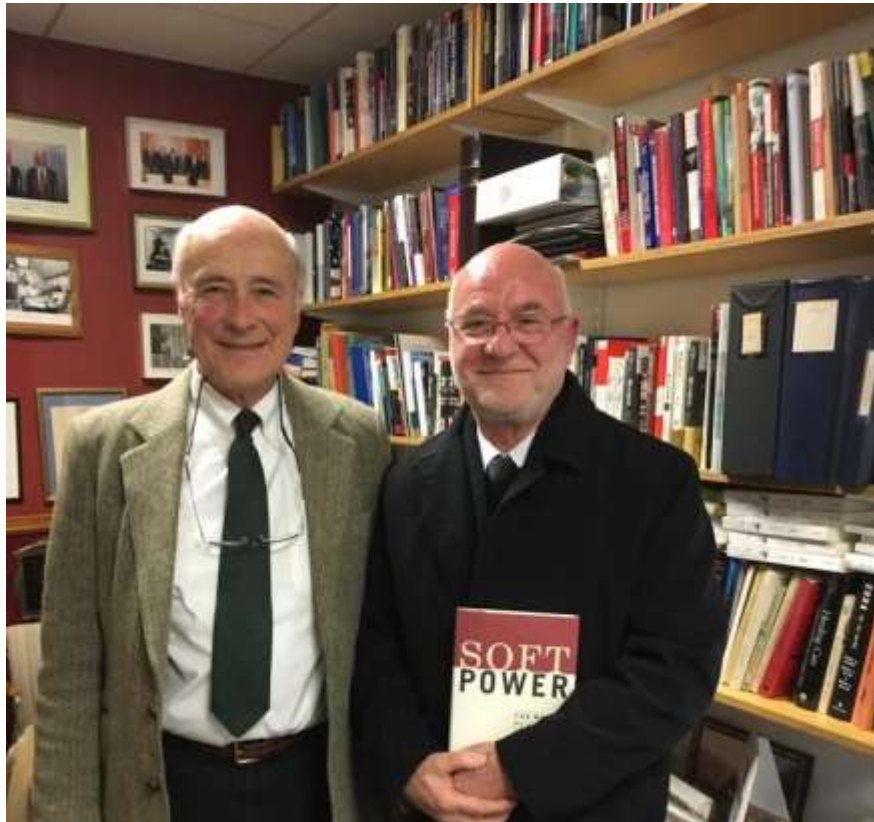

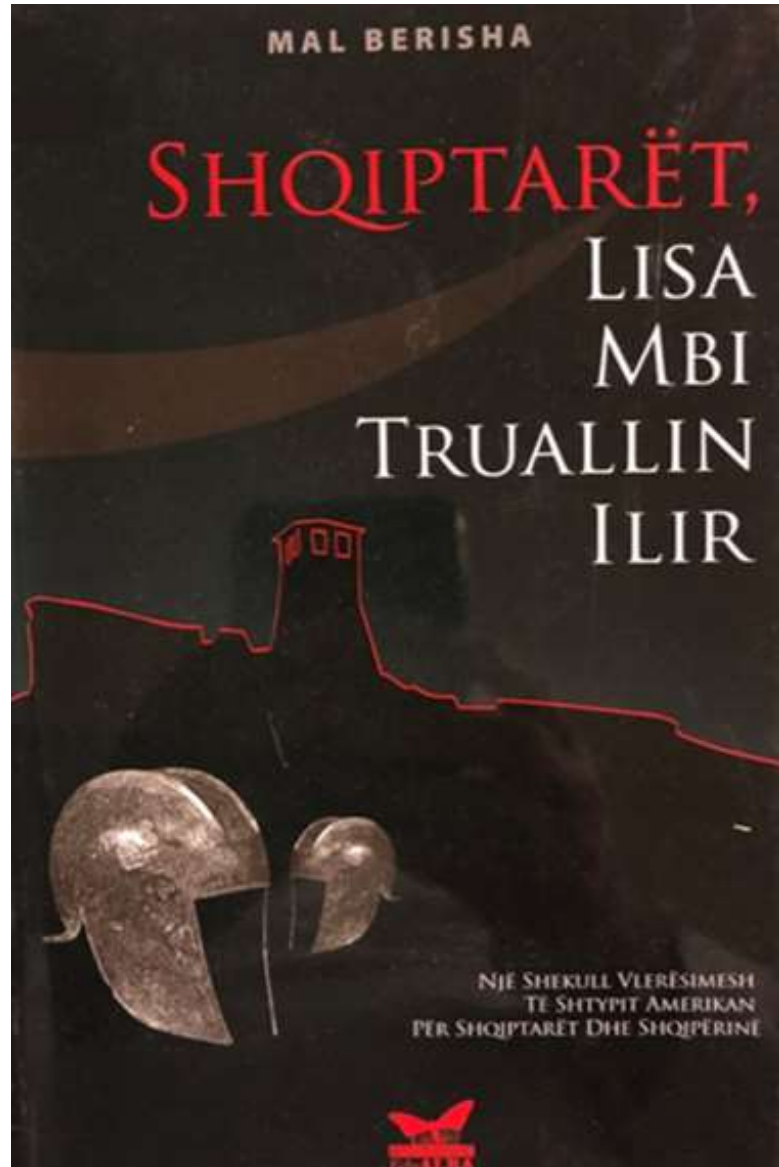
PRESENTATION OF CREDENTIALS TO HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II

The **Albanian Lahuta**, a traditional handcrafted instrument of exceptional artistry, created in filigree by the Albanian master artisan **Pirro**, was formally presented to **Her Majesty the Queen**. It was displayed with honor in the **Queen's Ambassadors' Hall**, prominently visible during the royal audience, and was subsequently preserved as part of the **British Kingdom Art Collection**.





10 October 2013 — The credentials ceremony took place in Dublin at **Áras an Uachtaráin**. On this occasion, the Ambassador presented His Excellency the President of Ireland, **Michael D. Higgins**, with a collection of his poems translated into Albanian by the Albanian poet, Irish citizen Ndrek Gjini.

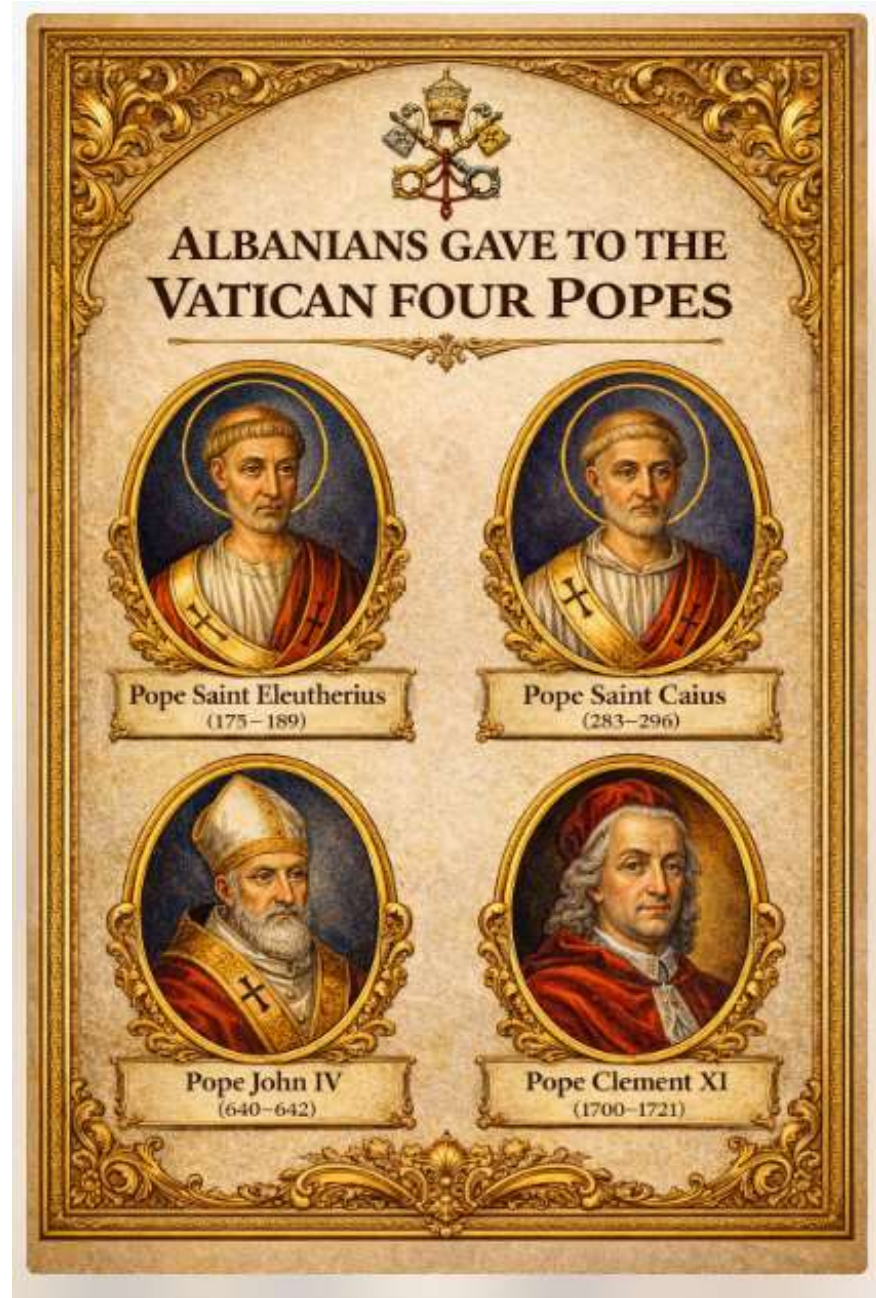

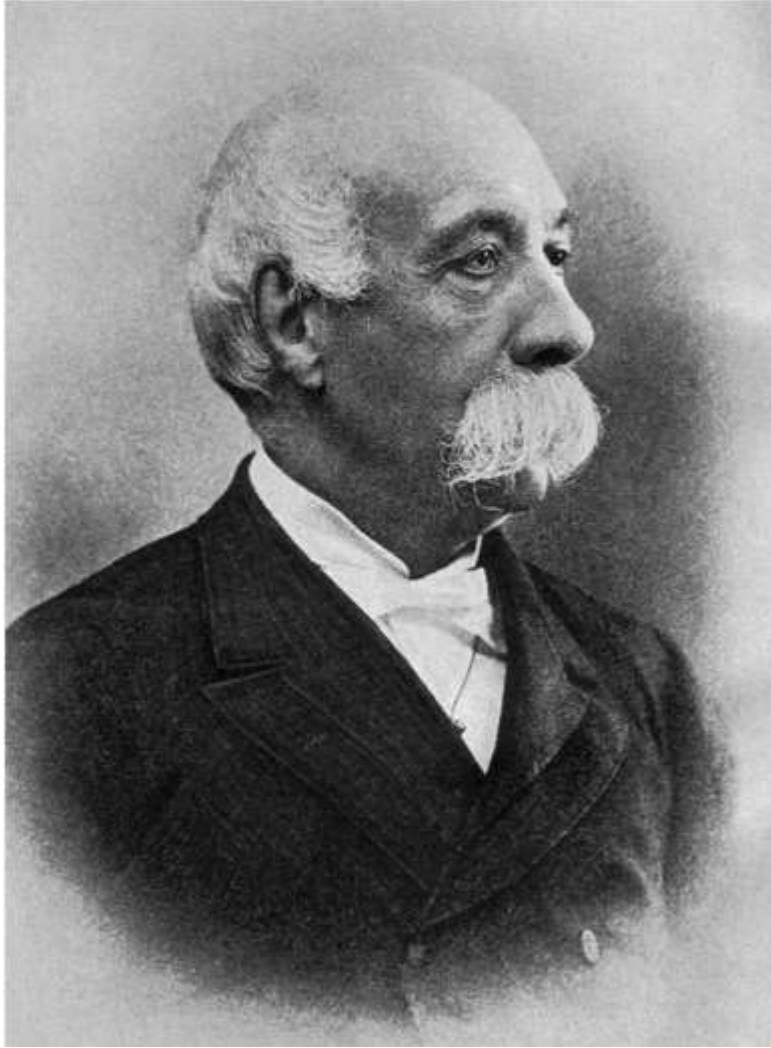

Pope Clement XI, born Giovanni Francesco Albani, was head of the Catholic Church and ruler of the Papal States from 23 November 1700 to his death in March 1721. Clement XI was a patron of the arts and of science.

FRANCESCO CRISPI

Francesco Crispi (1819–1901) was a crucial Italian Risorgimento leader and Prime Minister of Italy with Arbëreshë (Albanian) ancestry from Sicily. He identified as "an Albanian by blood and heart," spoke the Arbëreshë language, and was instrumental in the 1860 unification of Italy.

The **Arbëreshë** gave Italy a Prime Minister and statesman such as **Francesco Crispi**. They preserved Albanian culture during Ottoman rule, and their scholars were among the first to codify and write the Albanian language.

Muhammad Ali Pasha (1769–1849) was an Ottoman Albanian ruler who governed Egypt from 1805 to 1848 and is widely regarded as the founder of modern Egypt.

At the height of his power, he controlled vast territories across the Middle East and transformed Cairo into the center of a rising empire.

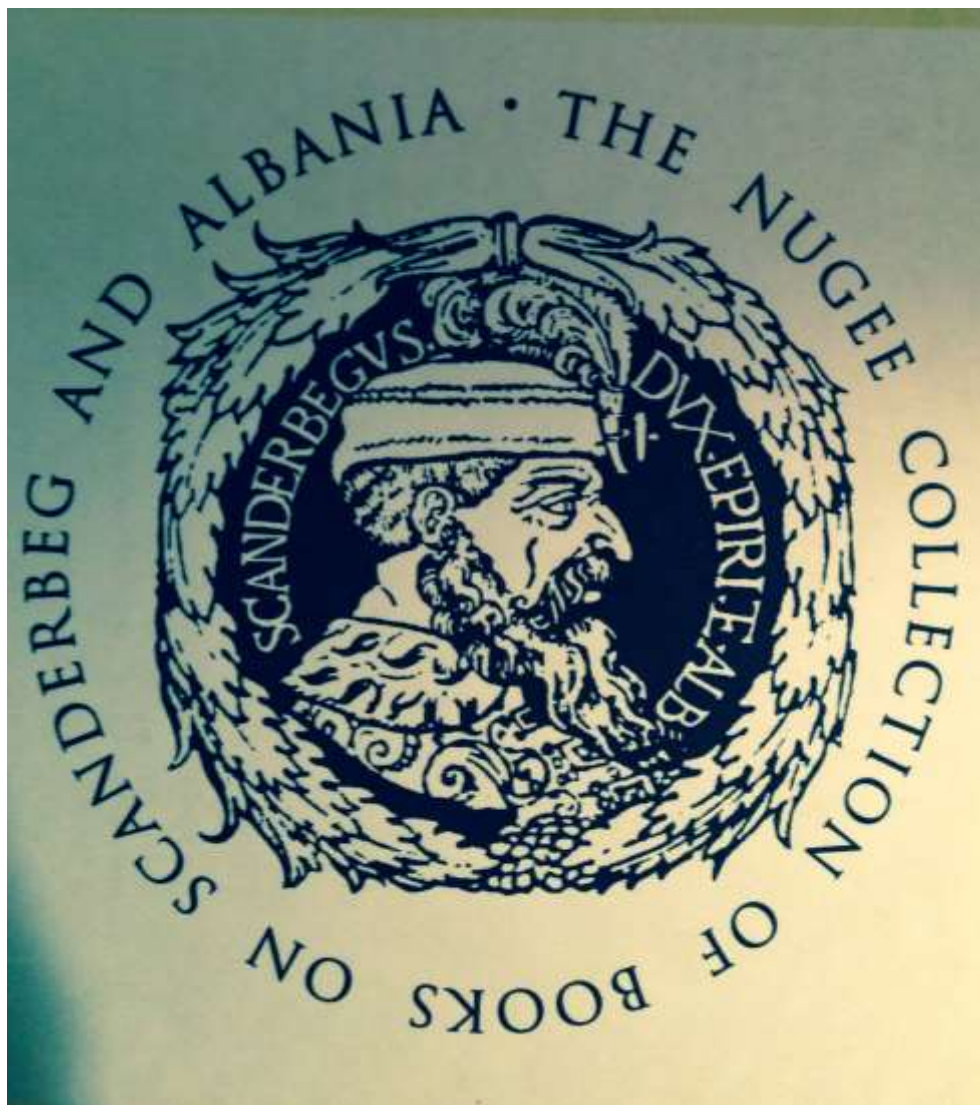
28 November 2012: To mark the 100th Anniversary of Independence, the Embassy of Albania placed the Bust of the Albanian National Hero, Skanderbeg. The unveiling ceremony was attended by the Lord Mayor of Westminster, Susie Burbridge, local authorities and the Albanian community in London and elsewhere.



The bust of Gjergj Kastrioti Skanderbeg was crafted by the Albanian sculptor **Kreshnik Xhiku**.

It was installed at **113 Inverness Terrace, London W2 6JH, Bayswater**, on 28 November 2012, marking the 100th anniversary of the Independence of Albania.



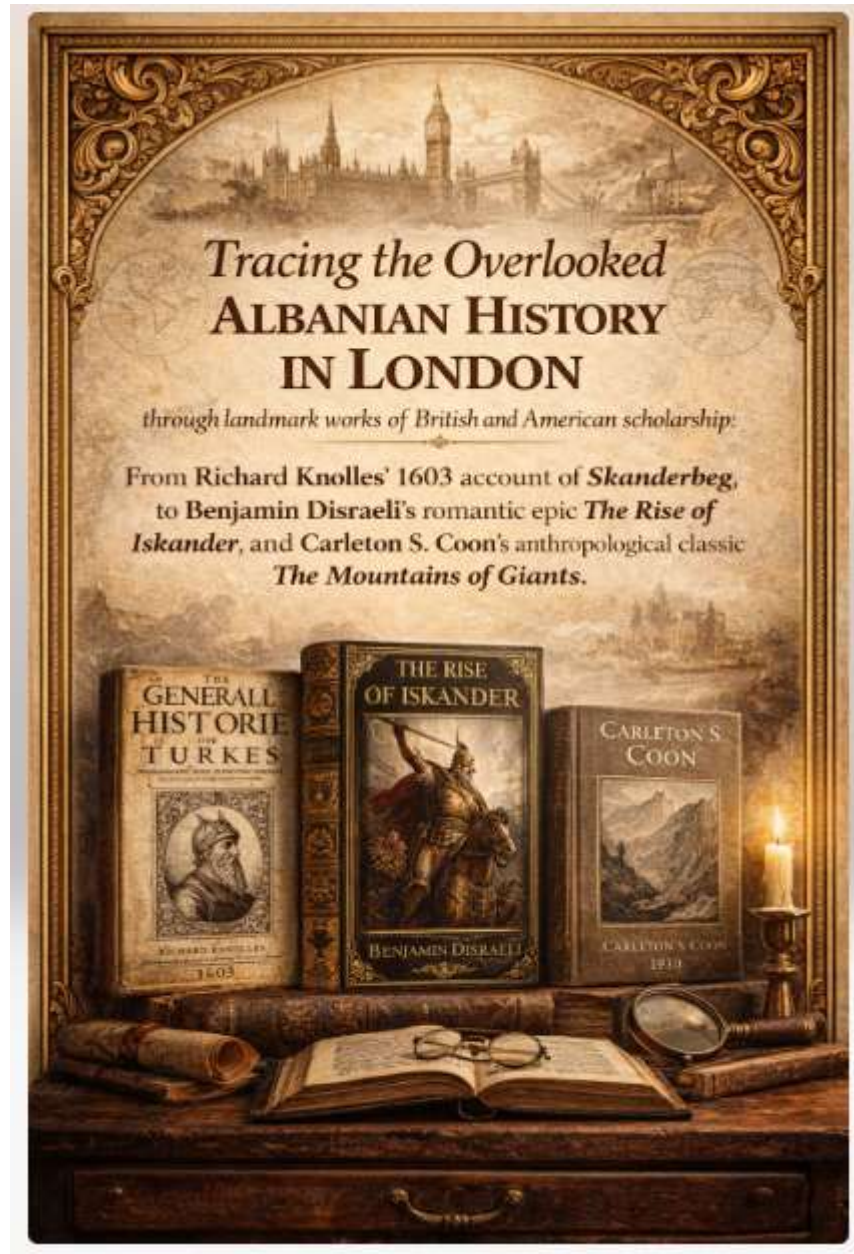

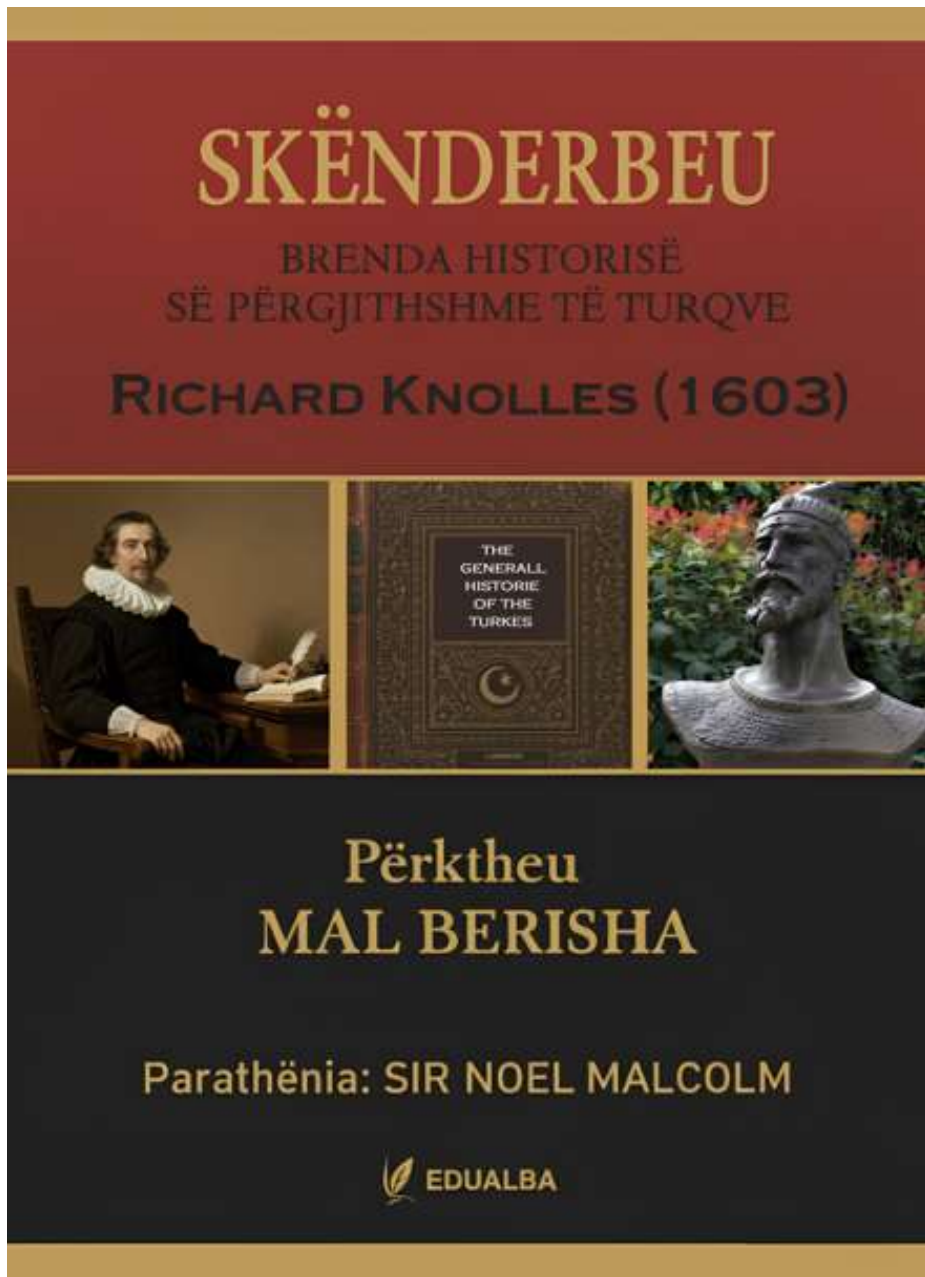

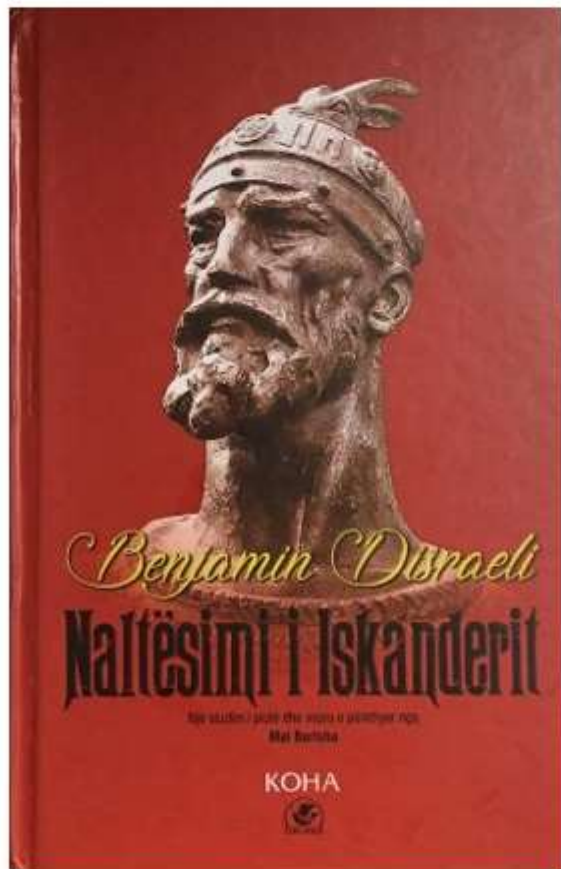


THE RISE OF ISKANDER

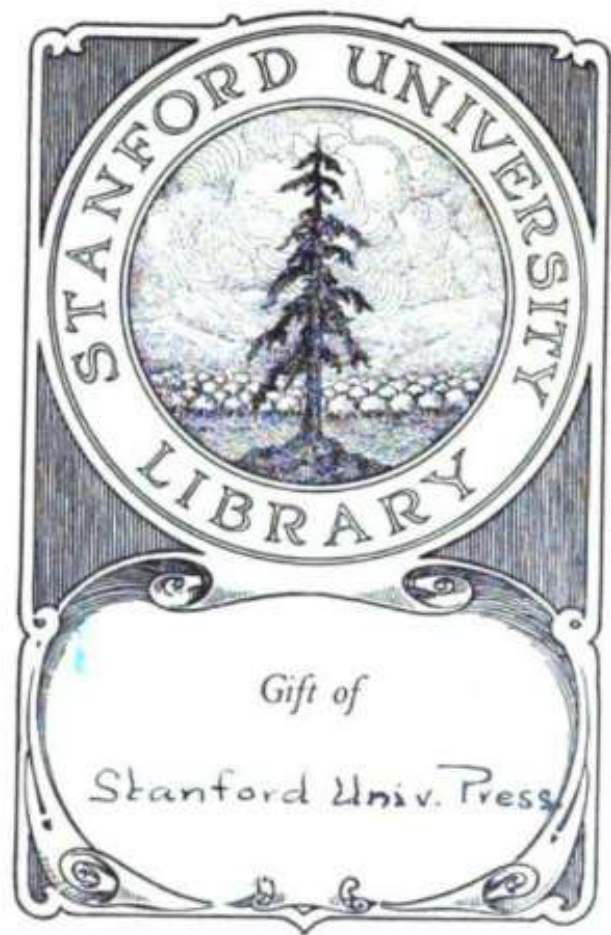

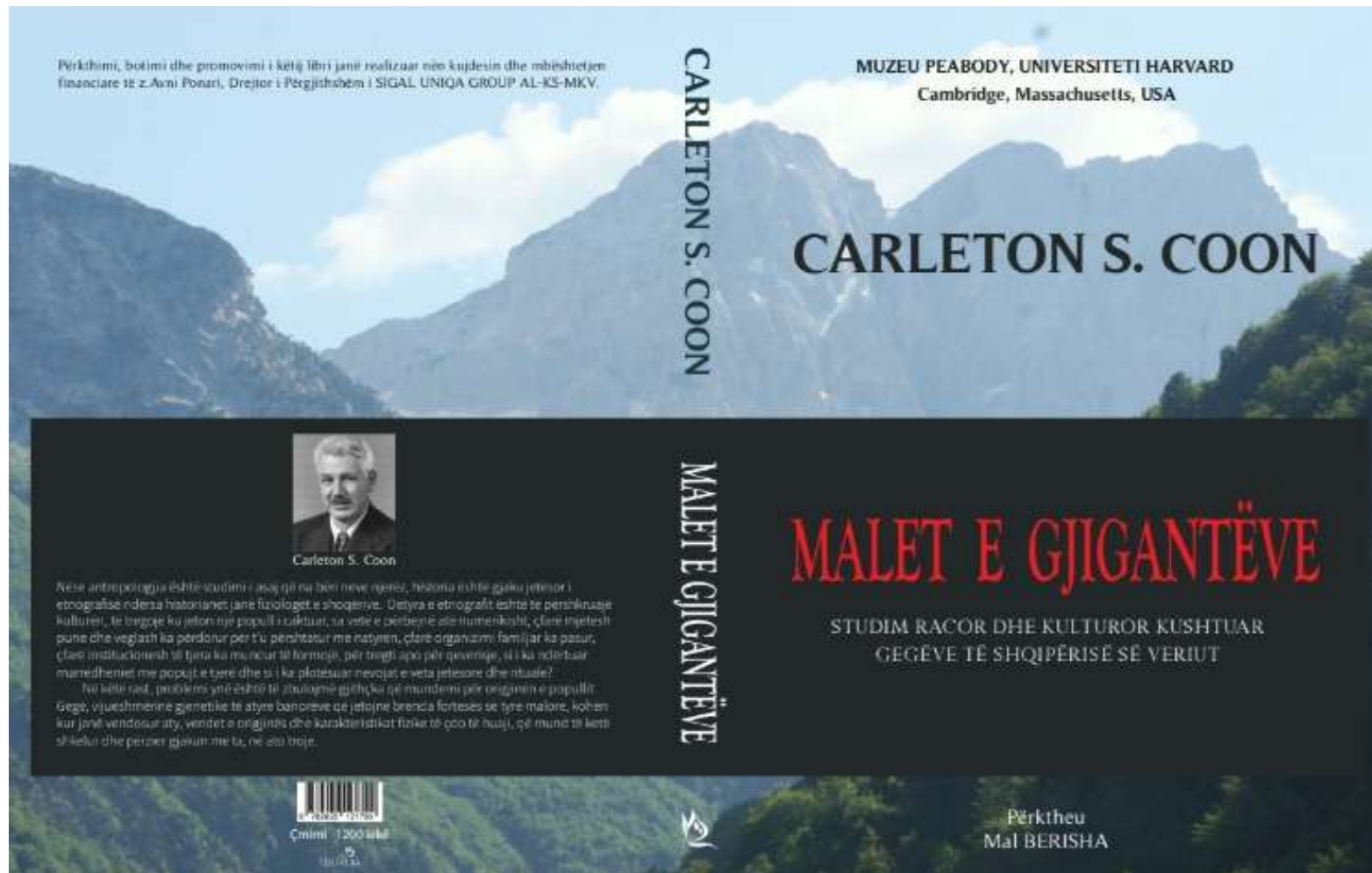
CARLETON S. COON, one of the greatest American anthropologists of the twentieth century, spent a full year in **northern Albania, 1929 – 1930**, studying the anthropological characteristics of the Albanian people. Based on this extensive fieldwork, he wrote the book

THE MOUNTAINS OF GIANTS,

a landmark study that documents the physical, social, and cultural features of the northern Albanian highlanders.

Charles Telford Erickson (1876–1966): The American Who Dedicated His Life to Albania

Published in Albanian language in **three volumes (2012)**, this work presents a thoroughly researched and well-documented biography of Erickson's life and legacy.

***ALBANIANS – THE ENIGMA OF THE

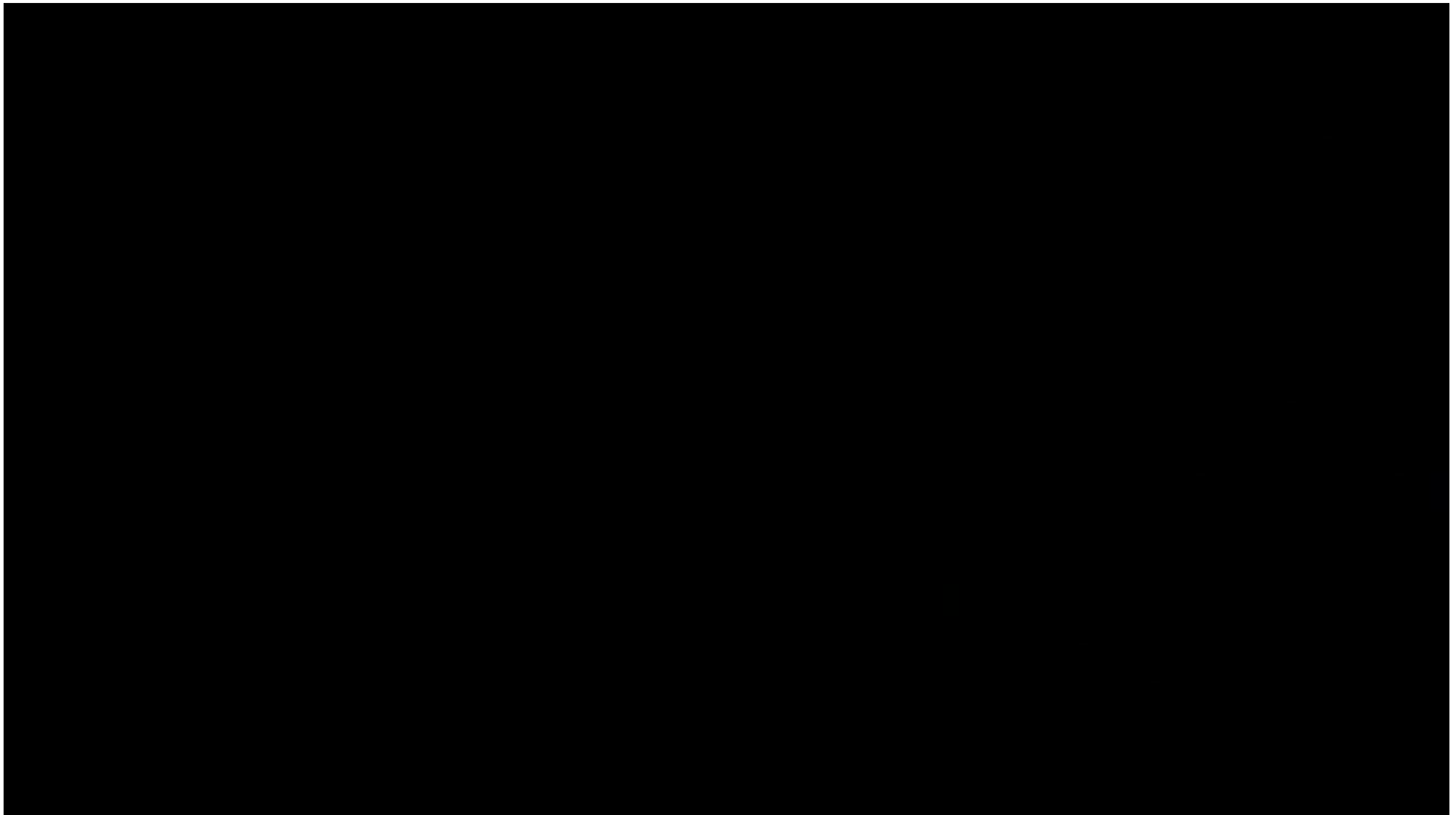

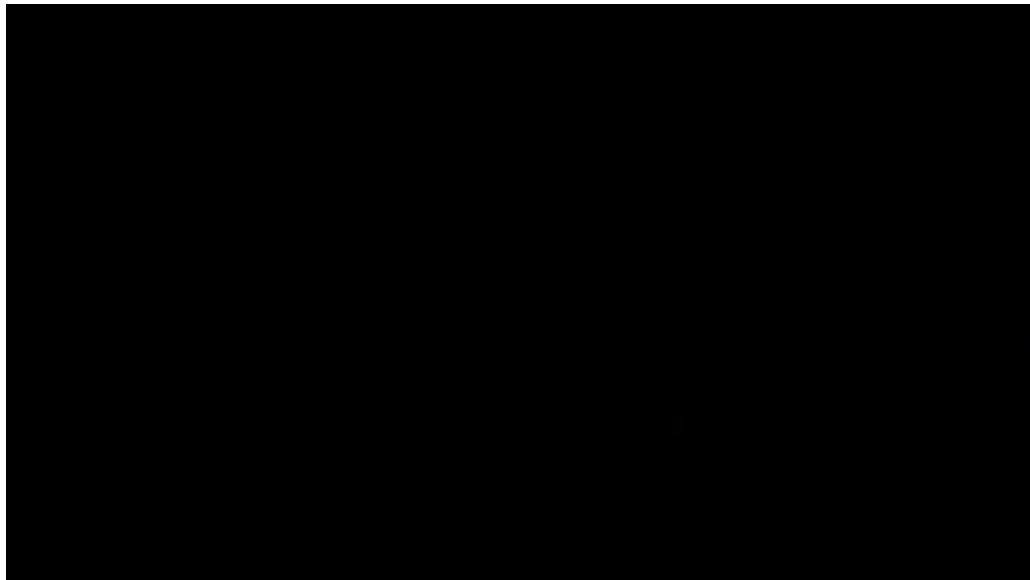

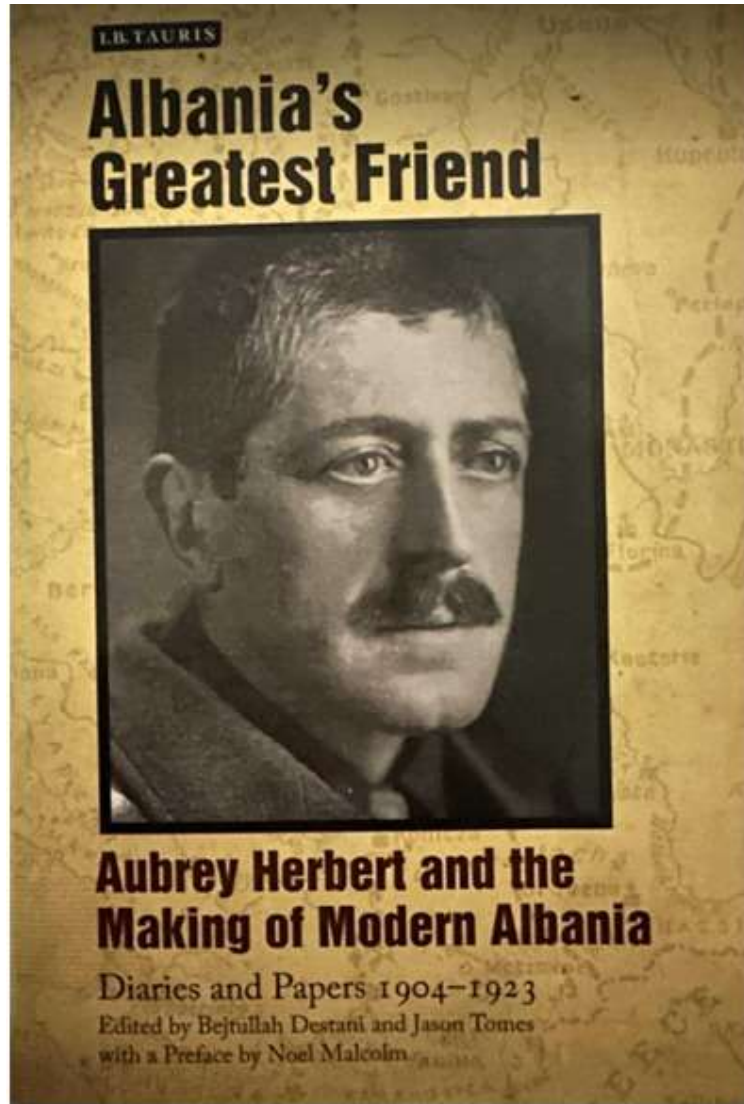
GRATITUDE IS THE PARAMETER OF THE HUMAN NOBILITY

The bust of Dr. Charles Telford Erickson, a work by sculptor Kreshnik Xhiku, is placed in front of the vocational school that bears his name.

The school was founded by him on 20 September 1925 in Golem, Kavajë, and remains fully operational today, standing as a lasting testament to Dr. Erickson's educational vision and humanistic legacy.



Founded in 1912 by **Colonel Aubrey Herbert** and supported by **Edith Durham**, the Anglo-Albanian Association has fostered British-Albanian understanding and support for Albania's independence and cultural identity. Today, the **Honorary President of the Anglo-Albanian Association is the renowned historian Sir Noel Malcolm.**

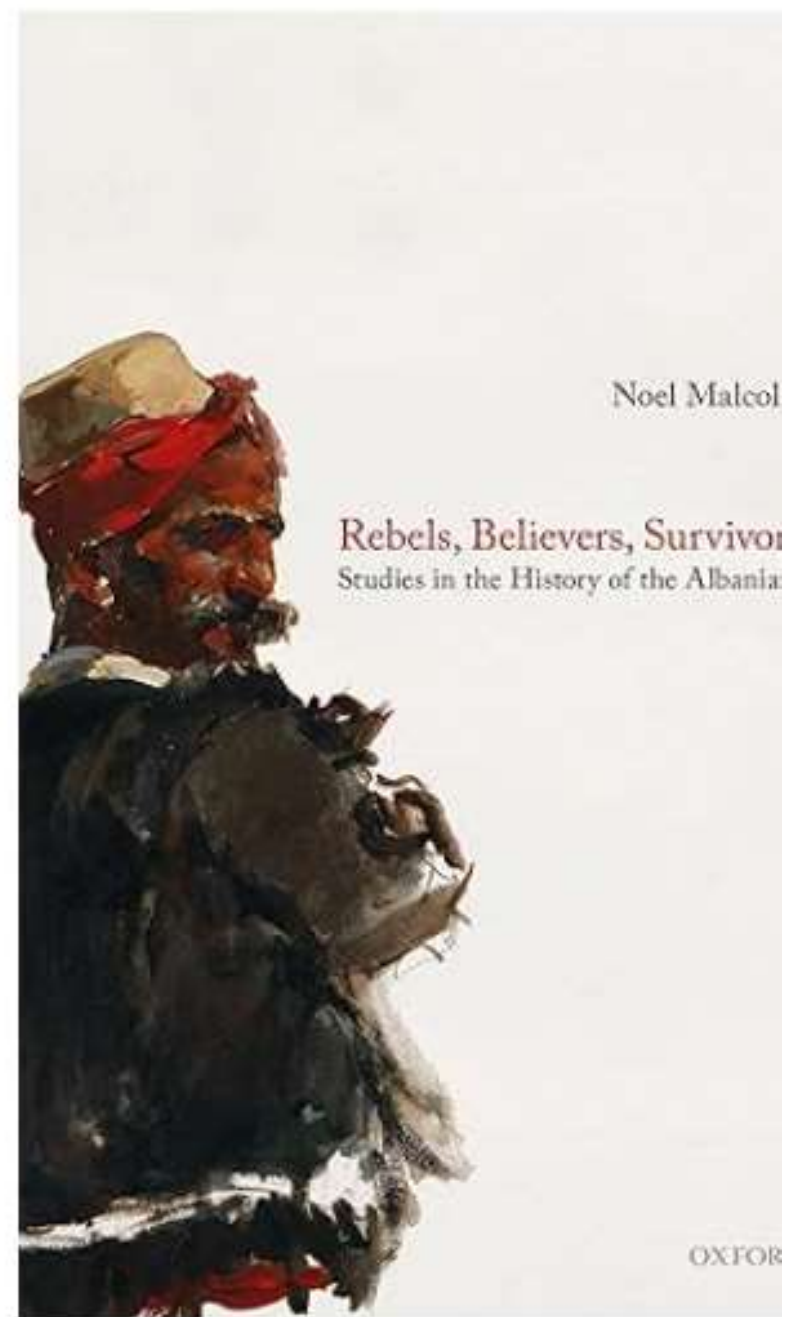
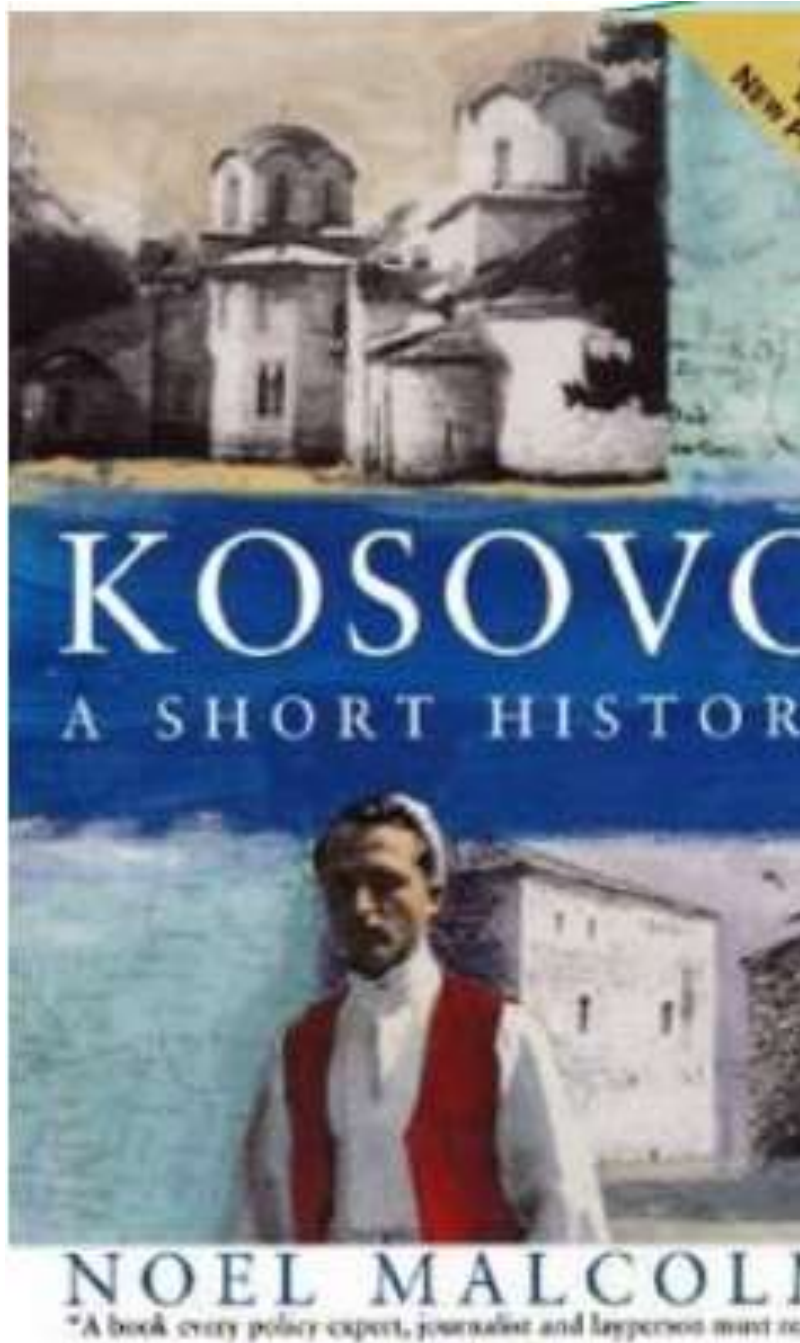

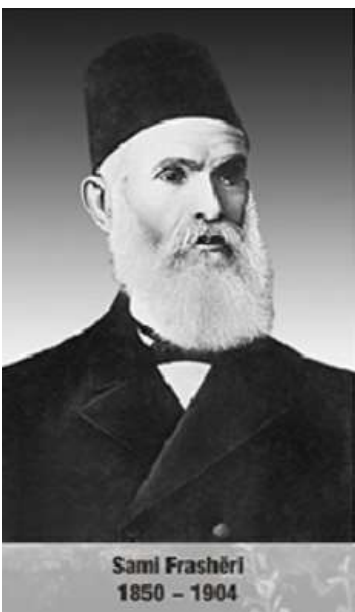

Herman Bernstein ishte një njeri universal i kohës së tij.

Ai ishte një hebra - amerikan, pjesëtar i një populli të njohur për zgjuarsinë dhe idetë e larta, por i parakohshëm dhe torturuar prej fanatizmindha shovinizmit të egër, në një kohë të historisë. I ballafaquar me përvojat më të hidhura të jetës, por edhe i mirur në qarqet më të larta intelektuale të kohës, ai u ushqye me parimet e lirisë dhe demokracisë amerikane. Heroi i kësaj libri nuk ishte thjesht përfaqësuesi i Shtetave të Bashkuara të Amerikës në Mbretërinë Shqiptare, por edhe një mik i vërtetë i shqiptarëve. Ai foli, shkroi, vizitoi vendet tona të bukura si mik i zinqerë, si mbështetës që e magjonte hapur simpatinë që ndjente për shtetin tonë. Bernstein kishte miqësi të ngushtë me Mirvetin Zog, i cili më pas urdhëroi misionet konsullorë shqiptare të lëshonin vizat për hebrajtë në rrezik, duke e lehtësuar Shqipërisë e vogël në strehë të sigurtë e bujare për ta. Trashëgimia e kësaj vepri tepër humane i shërben edhe sot diplomacisë shqiptare.

The names of seventy-five Albanian families who rescued Jews are engraved at the **Yad Vashem Memorial Museum** in Jerusalem, honoring them as **“Righteous Among the Nations.”**





14 December 2014:
A lecture on **Albanian–Jewish relations** was delivered at the **YIVO Institute for Jewish Research** in New York City, attended by leaders of the American Jewish community, researchers, scholars, and members of the Albanian community in the United States.

An interview with Ms. Felicita Jakoel, President of the Albania–Israel Association, presenting documented facts on how Albanians, from ordinary citizens to senior government officials during the period of German occupation, protected and saved Jews in Albania.



Mother Teresa (Anjezë Gonxhe Bojaxhiu, 1910–1997) was an Albanian Catholic nun and humanitarian, born in Skopje to an Albanian family. She dedicated her life to serving the poorest of the poor, especially in Calcutta, where she founded the **Missionaries of Charity** in 1950. She received the **Nobel Peace Prize in 1979** and was canonized in **2016** as **Saint Teresa of Calcutta**.

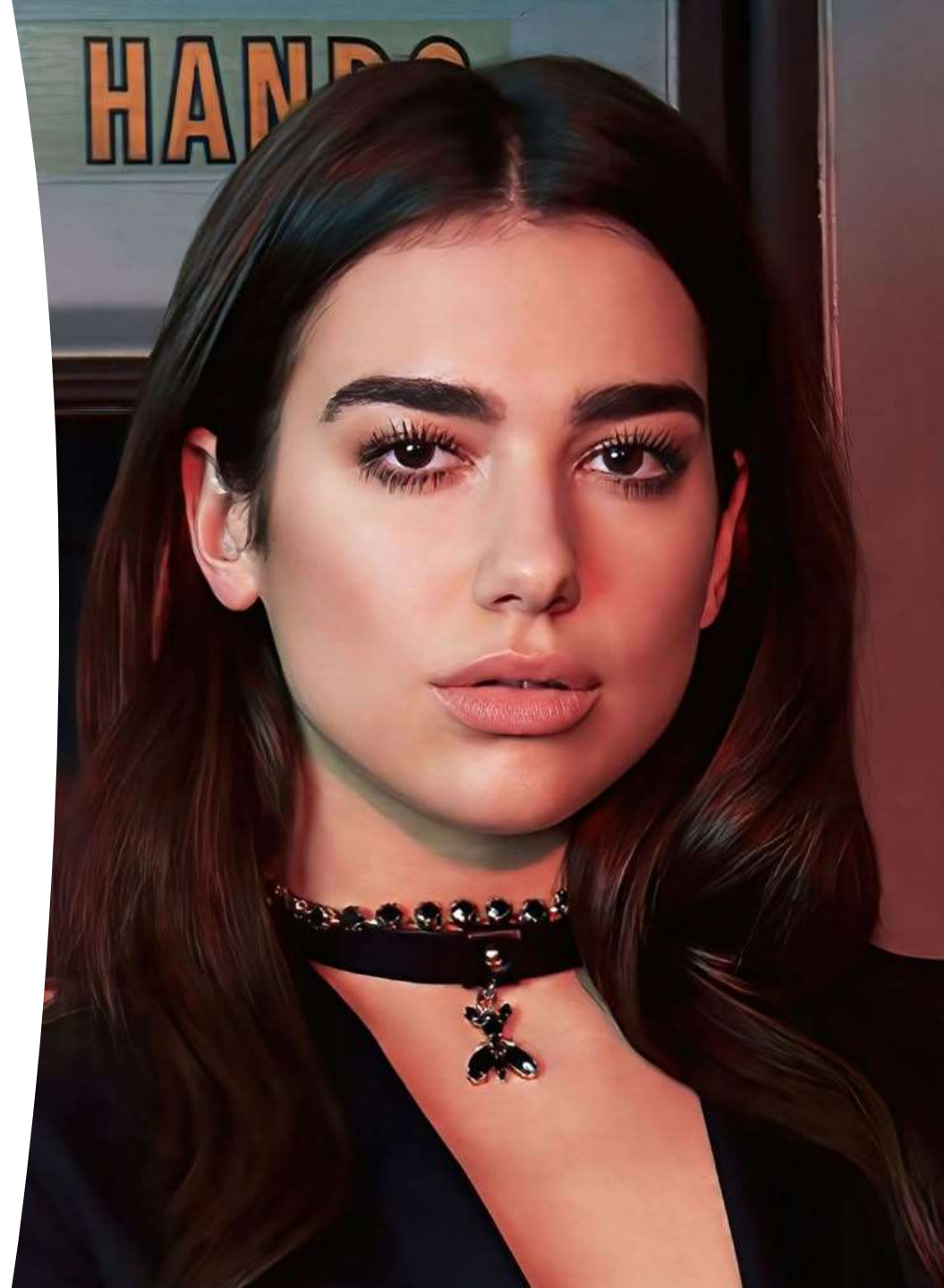
